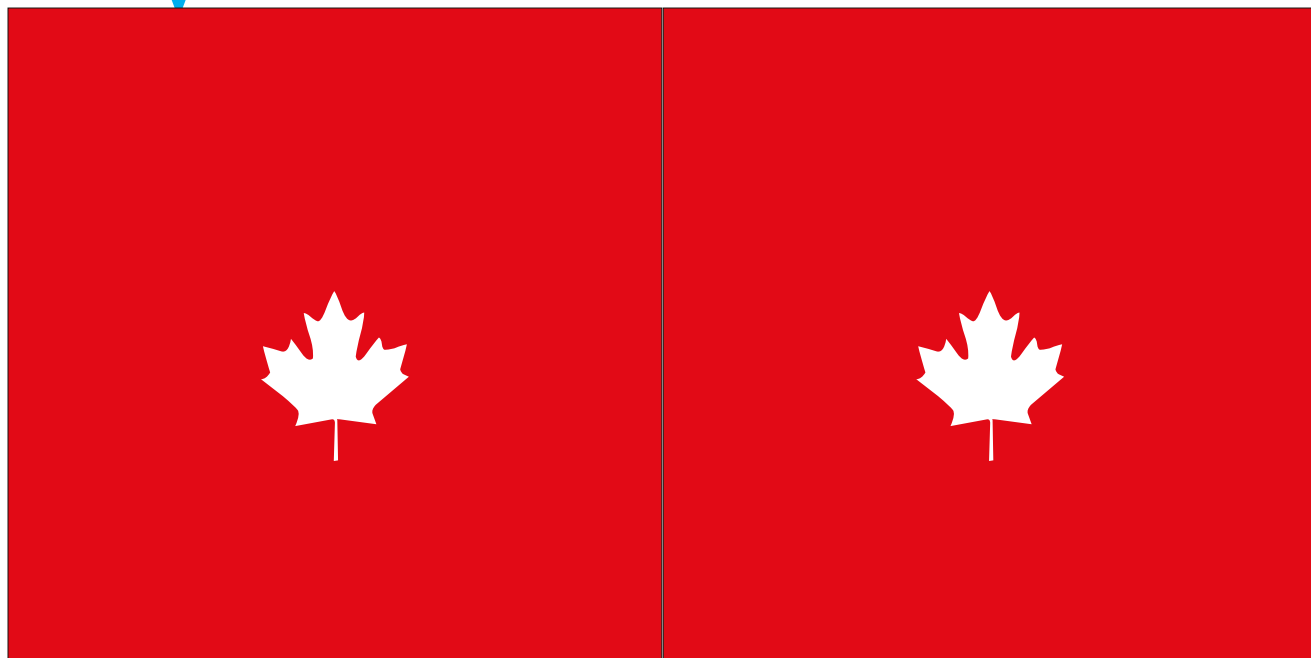
# Small Red Kit: Mittens, Hat & Scarf

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter of A4 format.  
Cut out the squares and the rectangle.

## Small Red Kit: Mittens



From the squares fold mittens, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 17-19. The height of the finished mitten will be 1/2 of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about 1 1/2 inches (4 cm).



## Small Red Kit: Hat



From this rectangle fold the hat, according the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 20-22. The width of the finished hat will be 1/3 of the long side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about 2 1/4 inches (5.8 cm).



## Small Red Kit: Scarf →

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter or A4 format. Cut out the rectangle.

Fold the scarf, according to the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 19-20. The width of the finished scarf will be  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the short side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about  $1 \frac{1}{4}$  inches (3 cm).



# Medium Red Kit: Mittens

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter or A4 format. Cut out the squares.

Fold mittens, according to the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 17-19. The height of the finished mitten will be 1/2 of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about 2 3/4 inches (6.5 cm).



# Medium Red Kit: Hat

Print this page on a white sheet of Letter or A4 format. Cut out the rectangle.

Fold the hat, according to the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 20-22. The width of the finished hat will be 1/3 of the long side of the original rectangle. In this case it will be about 3 1/2 inches (8.5 cm).

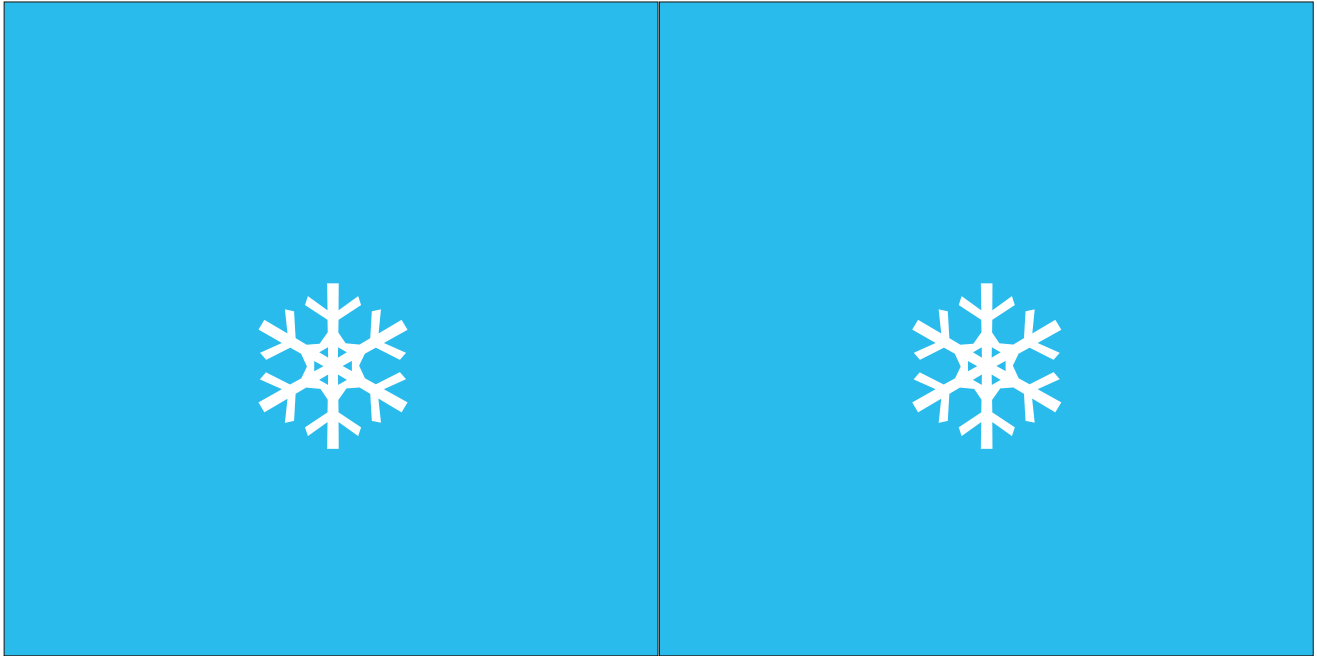

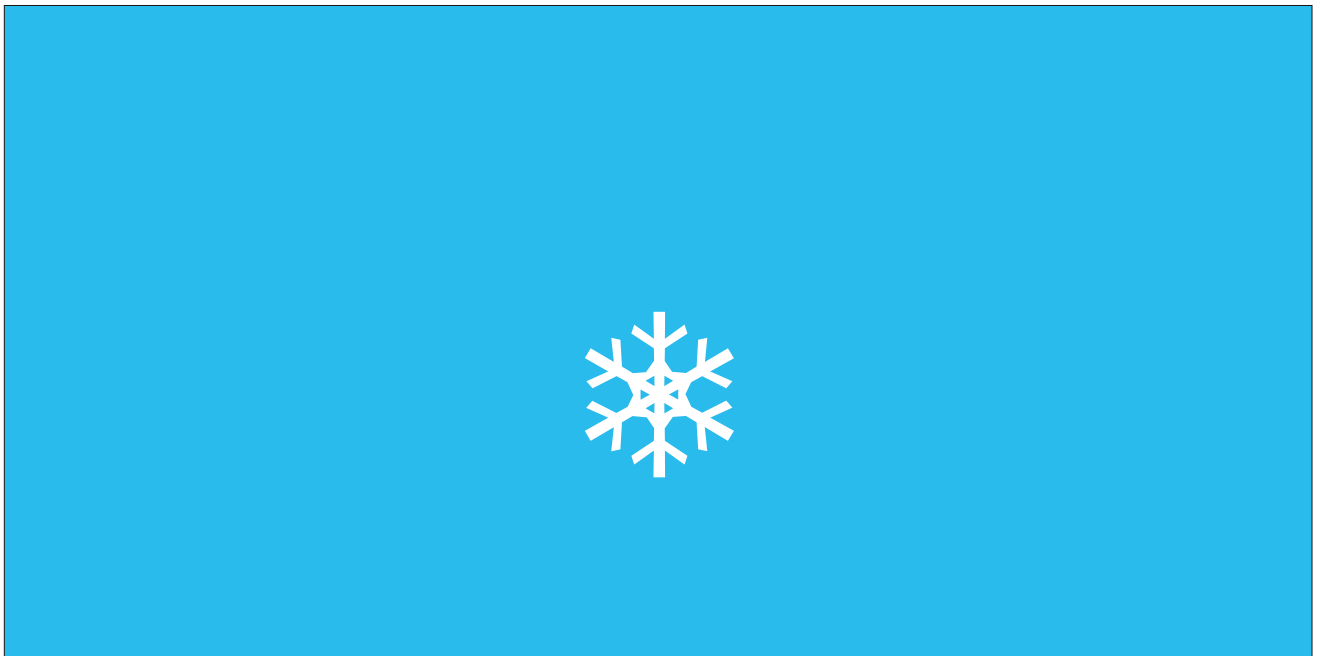

Fold mittens, according to the diagrams, presented in the eBook "Christmas Trees for Christmas Trees", on pages 17-19. The height of the finished mitten will be 1/2 of the side of the original square. In this case it will be about 2 3/4 inches (6.5 cm).



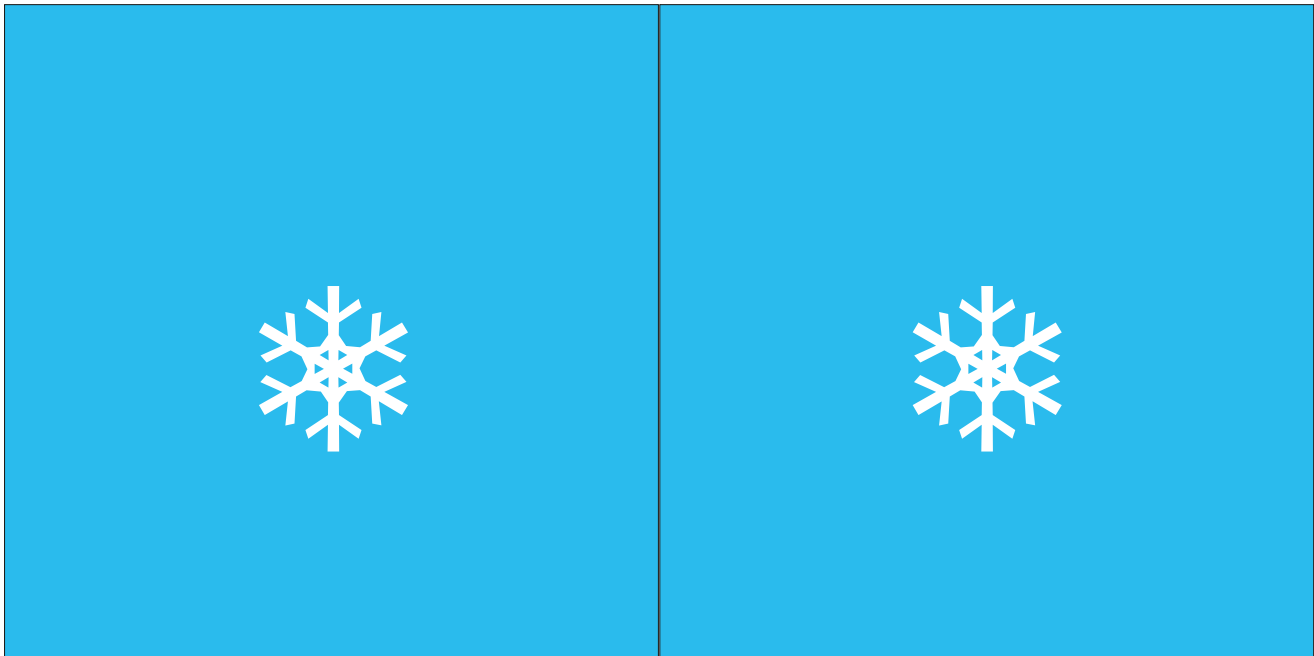
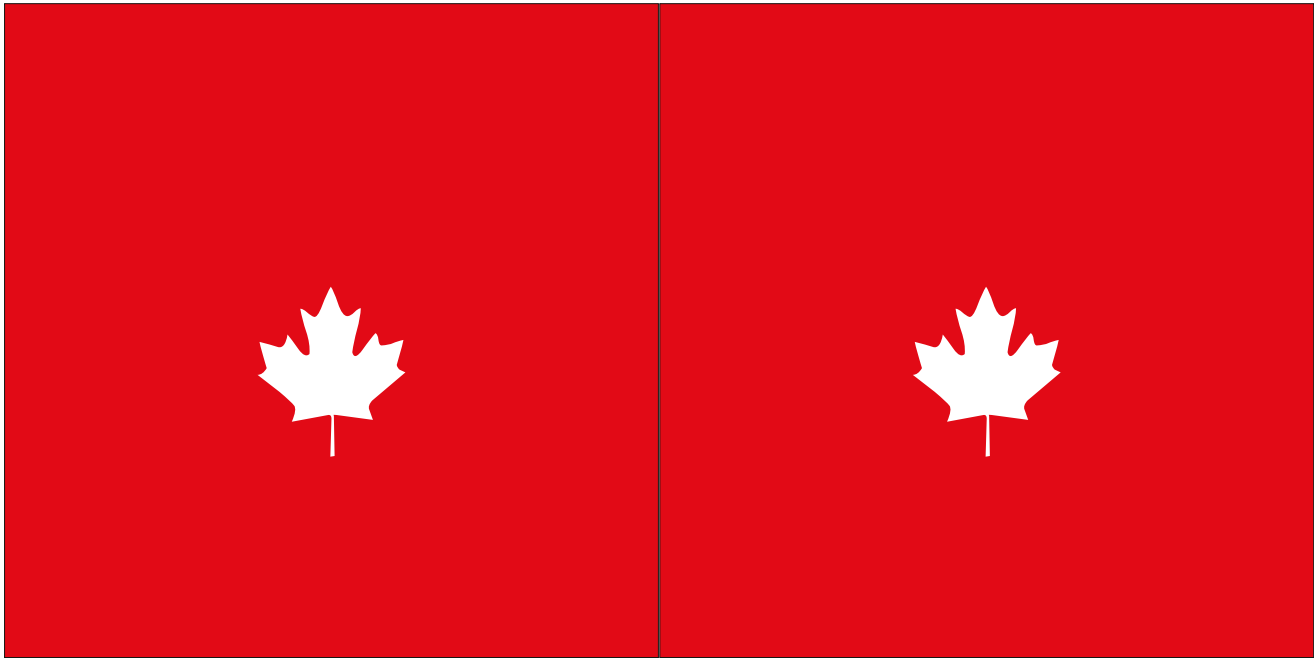
# Medium Blue Kit: Hat
